RESCUER CPR/AED

This class is designed for healthcare workers, nursing students and professional rescuers. Certification is valid for 2 years. Lifeguard certification for Professional Rescuer is good for 1 year.

INSTRUCTOR TRAINING

The 20-hour course is required to be eligible to teach Lay responder CPR/FA/AED. Prerequisites include approval by the Health & Safety Director and ability to pass CPR/FA challenge test.

This class will be held Friday from 5:30 pm to 9:30pm, Saturday from 8 am to 5 pm and Sunday 8 am to 5 pm.

WILDERNESS FIRST AID

Developed in conjunction with the Boy Scouts of America, this class is designed for individuals who will be in areas where help may be delayed more than 30 minutes. This 16 hour course involves outdoor scenarios.

BABYSITTER TRAINING

Designed for students 11-17, this 7-hour course teaches young adults resume' writing, accident prevention, age appropriate games, diapering, feeding infants and basic first aid.

BLOODEBORNE PATHOGENS

This course is designed in preventing disease transmission. It is an instructor-led training that meets OSHA's revised blood-borne pathogens standard, including OSHA's needle stick standard. Call the Black Hills Chapter of the American Red Cross for more details.

LIFEGUARD TRAINING

This is a required course for students age 15 or above to be certified to serve as a lifeguard. The 26-hour course includes Professional Rescuer CPR and can include the option of waterfront or water park lifeguard certification. Professional Rescuer CPR certification is valid for 1 year and lifeguard certification is valid for 3 years. To register call the Swim Center at 394-5223 or the YMCA at 718-9622.
